We have a large lighted arena with great footing, announcers stand, bleachers, picnic tables and restrooms. We share our facilities with the WRPM-Wild Rice Peacemakers the mounted shooters, 3-Gems Saddle Club and MnDRA- Minnesota Distance Riders Association. We also have an annual Memorial Ride the last weekend in September and promote good family fun with entertainment and a chili feed at the campground after.

As one of the largest and most diverse horse clubs in the area we encourage fun outdoor activities. Monthly events are posted on our website with open riding for our members the first weekend of each month and the Buckle Series Shows the 3rd Sunday of each month.
